ISTANBUL

- **Istanbul** - The largest city and the world's busiest and narrowest strait used for international navigation, located in north-western Turkey and straddles the strait Bosphorus, which provides the only passage from the Black Sea to the Mediterranean via the Sea of Marmara. Istanbul is home to several UNESCO World Heritage Sites.
- **Blue Mosque** - also known as Sultan Ahmed Mosque is a historical mosque in Istanbul. One of the most distinctive elements of this Istanbul mosque is that it has six minarets. It is dubbed the Blue Mosque because of over 20,000 handmade ceramic Iznik tiles that decorate the interior.
- **Hippodrome Square** - also known as The Sultanahmet Square. Once being a Byzantium hippodrome, the square itself hosts the famous historic places and sights. The Egyptian Obelisk, the Serpentine Column, the Colossus or the Column of Costantine Porphyrogenus are the famous trio of the monuments in heart of the Sultanahmet Square.
- **Hagia Sophia** - is a great architectural beauty and an important monument both for Byzantine and for Ottoman Empires. Once a church, later a mosque, and now a museum at the Turkish Republic.
- **Topkapi Palace** - It literally meant "Cannon Gate" in Turkish and was built in 1459 by Sultan Mehmed the Conqueror. It was of great importance in the 15th and 16th centuries when it was used by the Sultan and his bevy of concubines. It was converted into a museum after the fall of the Ottoman Empire and the creation of the Turkish Republic in 1924. It is made up of four different courtyards and various palace's opulent pavilions, jewel-filled Treasury and sprawling Harem.
- **Istanbul Grand Bazaar** - with 61 Covered Streets and over 4,000 Shops and 22 entrances & exit, it is like a small labyrinth, selling all kinds of goods.
- **Balat Old Town** - is one of the oldest city, the most diverse and its historic buildings and residents. The most iconic part of Balat is the district's colorful houses along sloping cobbled streets. These homes are mostly over 50-years-old, and in some cases are up to 200-years-old. Balat is a district that has traditionally been home to minorities in the city, with many Jewish families and Greek Orthodox families making it their homes.

CANAKKALE

- **Trojan Horse** - is one of the biggest attractions of Canakkale city. The "wooden horse" was made famous by the movie Troy. (Exclude Troy Museum)

SELCUK

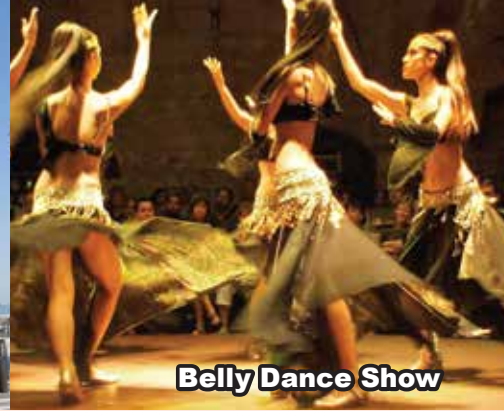
- **Ephesus Ancient City** - is Türkiye's most important ancient city, and one of the best preserved and restored. One can still stroll for hours along its streets, passing temples, theatres, libraries, houses, and statues. It contains such grand public buildings as the impressive Library of Celsus, the theatre, the Temple of Hadrian and the site of the sumptuous Temple of Artemis which was one of the Seven Wonders of the Ancient World.

- **Cotton Castle** - is a popular thermal center, home to a world-renowned natural wonder of calcite travertines full of warm. Its calcium and iron-rich waters are believed to have healing properties. The city grew and gained prominence thanks to its thermal springs.

CAPPADOCIA

- **Pigeon Valley** - Name comes from the thousands of pigeon houses that have been carved into the soft tuff since ancient times.
- **Uchisar 'Castle' Village** - This tall volcanic-rock outcrop and the tallest fairy chimney (1.350 m above sea level) is one of Cappadocia's most prominent landmarks and visible for miles around. also called as 'The eye of the Cappadocia'. It also includes secret tunnels with honeycombed structure built by locals to hide themselves from the warriors. The Uchisar Fortress has been on the list of UNESCO World Heritage Sites since 1985 and been also under preservation as a National Park since 1986.
- **Göreme Valley** - It is located in the middle of the valley of rock cones and fairy chimneys. It is one of the rare areas in the world, where you can see the innumerable fairy chimneys of nature, flowing water and lush plants under the valley. Cave churches and mosques with frescoes. Goreme National Park is listed as a dual cultural and natural heritage.
- **Underground City** - Once a place of refuge for 15000 Christians. Witness the ancient bedrooms, church, meeting hall and food storage rooms in this eight-storey city connected by 30km of corridors and passageways.
