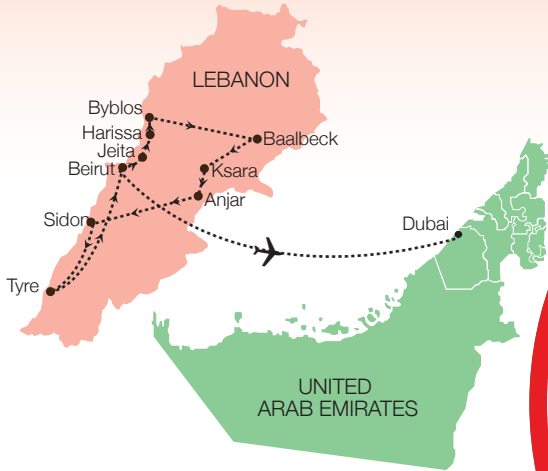

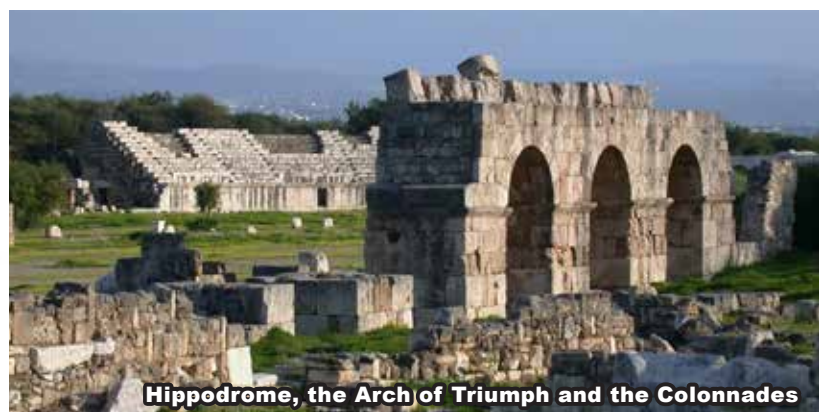

## BEIRUT (LEBANON)

- **Lebanon** is a Country in Western Asia, the Second Smallest Country in Continental Asia. Beirut is the Capital, the Largest City of and the Largest Seaport in Lebanon, an Ancient City of Culture, also Known as "Paris of the Middle East"
- **Beirut National Museum** - The collection begun after World War I , and the museum was officially opened in 1942. The museum has collections totaling about 100,000 objects, most of which are antiquities and medieval finds from excavations undertaken by the Directorate General of Antiquities.
- **Hamra Street** - is one of the main streets of the city of Beirut, Hamra Street was the centre of intellectual activity in Beirut during the 1960s and 1970s.
- **Lady Of Lebanon** - It is one of the most important shrines in the world honoring Mary, Mother of Jesus. The Statue of Our Lady of Lebanon is a French-made, 13-ton statue, made of bronze and painted white.
- **Beqaa Valley** - Beqaa Valley is actually a high plateau between the Mt Lebanon and Jebel Libnan Ash Sharqiyya (Anti-Lebanon) ranges. It's idyllically beautiful in parts and is home to the marvellous ruins of Baalbek .It also Lebanon's most important farming region.
- **Ksara Winery** - Founded in 1857 by Jesuit priests. Château Ksara developed the first dry wine in Lebanon. Ksara wine is most popular in Lebanon.
- **Castle of Sidon** was built by the crusaders in the thirteenth century as a fortress of the holy land. It is one of the most prominent historical sites in the port city of Sidon, Lebanon.
