TOURIST ATTRACTIONS:

TOKYO

- ◆ **Sensoji** - Sensoji (also known as Asakusa Kannon Temple) is a Buddhist temple located in Asakusa. It is one of Tokyo's most colorful and popular temples. You may enjoy shopping at the lively street called Nakamise-dori Street in front of the temple.
- ◆ **Shinjuku** - is a special ward in Tokyo. It is a major commercial and administrative centre, housing the northern half of the busiest railway station in the world (Shinjuku Station) and the Tokyo Metropolitan Government Building, the administration centre for the government of Tokyo. Shinjuku is also commonly used to refer to the entire area surrounding Shinjuku Station. The southern half of this area and of the station in fact belong to Yoyogi and Sendagaya districts of the neighboring Shibuya ward.
- ◆ **Ginza** - One of the city's top shopping districts, Ginza is packed with upmarket boutiques and ritzy cocktail and sushi bars. Fine jewelry is sold in the 1930s Wako Honkan department store, while ultramodern Ginza Place specializes in high-tech electronics. On weekends, main drag Chuo Dori becomes a stylish pedestrian promenade. Traditional Japanese dance and drama is staged at the landmark Kabuki-za theater.

HAKONE

- ◆ **Mount Fuji** - rising above the clouds, is the symbol of Japan and has provided a spiritual basis for the Japanese since ancient times, with the height of 3776meter. With unrivaled magnificence and a beautiful cone shape, Mt. Fuji has often been favored as the subject of paintings and literature throughout the centuries, and is now globally known as the symbol of Japan.
- ◆ **Lake Ashi Pirate Ship** - was formed in the caldera of Mt. Hakone after the volcano's last eruption 3000 years ago. Enjoy the boat ride while glazing the delight.

KYOTO

- ◆ **Fushimi Inari-Taisha** - The shrine sits at the base of a mountain also named Inari which is 233 meters above sea level. Early Japan, Inari was seen as the patron of business merchants and manufactures have traditionally worshipped Inari. Each of the torii at Fushimi Inari Taisha is donated by a Japanese business. First and foremost, though, Inari is the god of rice.
- ◆ **Kiyomizu Temple** - the temple is renowned for its construction which uses no nails to support the elaborate wooden structure of the main hall. And with a quaint old lane lined with pottery shops lead up to this famous temple.

MATSUMOTO

- ◆ **Matsumoto Castle** - is one of Japan's premier historic castles, along with Himeji and Kumamoto.

SHIRAKAWA-GO

- ◆ **Shirakawa-go Village** - the Historic Villages of Shirakawa-gō are one of Japan's UNESCO World Heritage Sites. These villages are well known for their houses constructed in the architectural style known as gash O-zukuri. The Gasshō-zukuri, "prayer-hands construction" style is characterized by a thatched and steeply slanting roof resembling two hands joined in prayer. The design is exceptionally strong and, in combination with the unique properties of the thatching, allow the houses to withstand and shed the weight of the region's heavy snowfalls in winter.
- ◆ **Wada House** - was built in the middle of the Edo period, giving it a proud history of more than three hundred years. It's the largest gassho-style private residence in Shirakawa village, and is a nationally designated Important Cultural property. It's called Wada House because the Wada family is still currently living here, using the space on the premises that's not open to the public.

TAKAYAMA

- ◆ **Takayama Old Town** - Alpine Streets retaining the traditional Japanese style, walking in the Edo period in Japan among the primary building ancient taste, elegant and quiet atmosphere, showing the traditional beauty of Japanese culture, the alpine region's most popular tourist attractions.

OSAKA

- ◆ **Osaka Castle Park** - This metropolitan space is dotted with greenery and parks. Every year in March, tourists, photographers, and flower-lovers alike flock to the area to see the beautiful cherry blossoms in bloom. However, Osaka's parks are beautiful all year round; here we explore some of the city's most attractive natural spaces.
- ◆ **Shinsaibashi Shopping Arcade** - a covered shopping street, liveliest and it line with many interesting shop.

观光景点:

东京

- ◆ **浅草雷门观音寺** - 建于7世纪的佛庙, 其象征物是风雷神门, 上面挂着写有“雷门”两个大字的大红灯笼, 这里每天都有前来参拜的观光客, 终年熙熙攘攘。您也可在该寺前的热闹街道“仲世见”购物, 此处满布出售各种纪念品的商铺以及当地小吃的日式店铺。
- ◆ **新宿购物区** - 东京都政府大楼、高楼大厦林立的事务所一条街。以购物、娱乐综合设施为中心的新宿, 被誉为不夜城的歌舞伎町为中心的日本少有的娱乐城。
- ◆ **银座** - 是位于日本东京都中央区的商业区, 以国际知名的百货公司、精品店、餐厅和咖啡馆等设施而闻名, 是东京其中一个代表性地区。被认为是世界上最昂贵、最豪华的繁华区之一。在过去曾与日本桥和神田一起构成了下町的核心。

箱根

- ◆ **富士山** - 富士山海拔3776米, 是日本的第一高峰。它气势雄伟, 是其他山峰所不及, 呈圆锥形的山姿十分优美, 常常被用来作为绘画和文字的创作题材, 它作为日本的象征, 名扬全世界。
- ◆ **芦之湖海盜船** - 乘海盜船游览背倚着富士山的芦之湖, 湖山相映, 不同的季节有不同的景致和情趣。

京都

- ◆ **伏见稻荷神社** - 每年都有大量的香客前来神社祈求农作丰收, 生意兴隆, 交通安全。另外起源于江户时代的习俗, 前来此地许愿的人们往往会捐款在神社境内竖立一座鸟居来表达对神明的敬意, 使其神社的范围内竖有数量惊人的大小鸟居, 而以【千本鸟居】之名而闻名日本全国乃至于海外。
- ◆ **京都清水寺** - 历史悠久的寺庙, 整座建筑完全不用铁打钉锁。沿途坡道两旁是日式古老建筑及商店, 摆满了各种各式的日本手工艺品, 陶瓷, 日本娃娃等, 不胜枚举。

松本

- ◆ **松本城** - 松本城是日本最雄伟的城堡之一。共五层的天空守阁于16世纪末建成, 是日本现存最古老的天空守阁。

白川乡

- ◆ **合掌村** - 于1995年列入世界文化遗产, 因为冬天的景色如同童话故事中情景一般, 故被誉为『冬日的童话村』。这是日本一种特殊的民宅形式, 特色是以茅草覆盖的屋顶, 呈人字型的屋顶如同双手合十一般, 于是就被称为【合掌】。合掌造为木造建筑物, 在兴建的过程中完全不用钉子, 但仍然十分坚固。合掌造的屋顶十分陡峭, 这是使积雪容易滑落不会堆积, 以避免冬季的大雪将屋顶压垮。
- ◆ **和田家** - 建于江户时代中期, 在白川乡是拥有300年以上悠久历史的最大规模合掌造民家, 也是国家指定重要文化财。如同“和田家”这个名字, 和田一家仍然居住在展示部分以外的空间。

高山

- ◆ **高山古街** - 高山古街保留传统日式风格, 走在日本江户时代原色古味的建筑当中, 幽雅静谧的气氛, 展现了日本文化传统美, 是高山地区有人气旅游景点。自古以来, 一直是飞驒地区(现在的岐阜县北部)经济重地的高山古街有著“飞驒的小京都”之称。

大阪

- ◆ **大阪城公园** - 为大阪著名的景点之一。历史悠久的大阪城, 系丰臣秀吉于1586年所建, 是由雄伟的石墙砌造而成, 登上高五层八阶的天守阁, 可以瞭望整个大阪市。城内的历史博物馆里保存有丰臣秀吉的木像、武器和艺术作品等。还有在西之丸庭园, 有一片宽阔的草原和曾遭祝融烧毁并再度重建的外堀、太平门等古迹, 也是游客放松心情的好去处。
- ◆ **心斋桥** - 高大阪最大的购物区, 也是日本最长的天缝式购物街, 集中了许多精品屋和专卖店还有很多饮食店, 既有日式料理, 也可以品尝到中国, 韩国, 亚洲, 美洲和欧洲等世界各地的料理。
