ROME

- **Trevi Fountain** - is a fountain in the Trevi district in Rome, Italy, designed by Italian architect Nicola Salvi and completed by Pietro Bracci. It is the largest Baroque fountain in the city and one of the most famous fountains in the world.
- **Roman Forum** - is a rectangular forum (plaza) surrounded by the ruins of several important ancient government buildings at the center of the city of Rome.
- **Colosseum** - Built of concrete and stone, it was the largest ampitheatre of the Roman Empire, and is considered one of the greatest works of Roman architecture and engineering. It is the largest amphitheatre in the world.

VATICAN CITY

- **St. Peter's Square** - is a large plaza located directly in front of St. Peter's Basilica in the Vatican City, the papal enclave inside Rome, directly west of the neighborhood or rione of Borgo.
- **St. Peter's Basilica** - Is a Late Renaissance church located within Vatican City. St. Peter's is the most renowned work of Renaissance architecture and remains one of the largest churches in the world.

ASSISI

- **St. Francis Basilica** - is the mother church of the Roman Catholic Order of Friars Minor Conventual in Assisi, a town in the Umbria region in central Italy, where Saint Francis was born and died. It is a Papal minor basilica and one of the most important places of Christian pilgrimage in Italy.
- **Basilica Di Santa Chiara** - was built in the 13th century and has undergone several renovations over the centuries. The basilica also houses the crucifix, before which Saint Francis of Assisi prayed and received his famous vision, which urged him to embrace poverty and begin his spiritual journey.

VENICE

- **The Bridge of Sighs** - Is a bridge located in Venice, northern Italy. The enclosed bridge is made of white limestone and has windows with stone bars. It passes over the Rio di Palazzo and connects the New Prison to the interrogation rooms in the Doge's Palace.
- **Murano Glass Blowing** - is glass made on the Venetian island of Murano, which has specialized in fancy glass wares for centuries.
- **The Grand Canal** - is a canal in Venice, Italy. It forms one of the major water-traffic corridors in the city. Public transport is provided by water buses and private water taxis.

FLORENCE

- **Piazzale Michelangelo** - is a square with a panoramic view of Florence.
- **Piazza Signoria** - is an L-shaped square in front of the Palazzo Vecchio in Florence, Italy. It is the focal point of the origin and of the history of the Florentine Republic and still maintains its reputation as the political hub of the city.

MILAN

- **The Galleria Vittorio Emanuele II** - is the world's oldest shopping mall, the Galleria is named after Victor Emmanuel II, the first king of the Kingdom of Italy.

VERONA

- **Romeo and Juliet Balcony** - In Verona, it features the balcony and in the small courtyard, a bronze statue of Juliet. The metal of its chest is worn bare due to a legend that if a person strokes the right breast of the statue, that person will have good fortune and luck in love.

GENOA

- **Piazza Matteotti** - is one of the main squares of Genoa.
- **Palazzo Ducale** -The Doge's Palace is a historical building in Genoa, northern Italy.
- **Genoa Cathedral** - Cathedral of Saint Lawrence ds a Roman Catholic cathedral in the Italian city of Genoa. It is dedicated to Saint Lawrence and is the seat of the Archbishop of Genoa.
- **Via Giuseppe Garibaldi** - is street in the historical Centre of Genoa, in Northwestern Italy, well known for its ancient palaces.

CINQUE TERRE

- **Cinque Terre** - which means Five Lands, comprise the five small coastal villages of Riomaggiore, Manarola, Corniglia, Vernazza and Monterosso located in the Italian region of Liguria. They are listed on the UNESCO World Heritage List.
- **Monterosso al Mare** - is a town and comune in the province of La Spezia, part of the region of Liguria. It is one of the five villages in Cinque Terre. The area is famous for its many lemon trees and It is also renowned for its white wines, grapes, and olives.
- **Vernazza** - is one of the 5 centuries-old villages that make up the Cinque Terre, on northwest Italy's rugged Ligurian coast. Colorful houses surround its small marina. The Santa Margherita di Antiochia Church has a bell tower topped by an elegant cupola. Clinging to the rocks, Doria Castle is a medieval defensive structure with a cylindrical tower.
- **Corniglia** - is a frazione of the comune of Vernazza in the province of La Spezia, Liguria, northern Italy. Corniglia is not directly adjacent to the sea. To reach Corniglia, it is necessary to climb the Lardarina leads to the village.
- **Manarola** - is a small town, a frazione of the comune of Riomaggiore, in the province of La Spezia, Liguria, northern Italy. It is the second-smallest of the famous Cinque Terre towns frequented by tourists. Most of the houses are bright and colourful. Manarola's primary industries have traditionally been fishing and wine-making. The Via dell'Amore ("Love's Trail") is a path connecting Riomaggiore to its frazione Manarola, also part of the Cinque Terre.
- **Riomaggiore** - is a village and comune in the province of La Spezia, situated in a small valley in the Liguria region of Italy. It is the first of the Cinque Terre one meets when travelling north from La Spezia.

PISA

- **Leaning Tower** - Pisa is a city in Italy's Tuscany region best known for its iconic Leaning Tower. Already tilting when it was completed in 1372, the 56m white-marble cylinder is the bell tower of the Romanesque, striped-marble cathedral that rises next to it in the Piazza dei Miracoli.

CIVITA DI BAGNOREGIO

- **Civita Di Bagnoregio** - is a small medieval town located in the region of Lazio, Italy. It is known for its picturesque hilltop location and its unique architecture. The town is situated on a volcanic rock formation, which has eroded over time, creating a narrow and precarious land bridge that connects it to the surrounding valley. Civita di Bagnoregio is often referred to as the "dying city" or the "city that is about to die" due to the gradual erosion of the rock on which it was built.
